I have the honor to refer to the United States-Korea Free Trade Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") signed in Washington, D.C. on June 30, 2007, and to the exchange of letters completed on November 18, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as the "Exchange of Letters") between the Government of the United States of America (United States) and the Government of the Republic of Korea (Korea) regarding the amendment and replacement in their entirety of Annex 4-A (Specific Rules of Origin for Textile or Apparel Goods), Annex 6-A (Specific Rules of Origin), and Appendix 6-A-1 (Correlation Table for Footwear) of the Agreement, as set forth in the Appendices to the Exchange of Letters.

I have the further honor to inform you that the Government of the United States has completed the necessary internal legal procedures to bring the revised Annexes and Appendix of the Agreement into force and would like to propose that the amendments come into force on January 1, 2014.
